Snapper Grouper Amendment 20 Wreckfish Fishery

Addresses revising the current wreckfish ITQ program

- Program review completed in December 2009
- Survey of shareholders and a shareholder meeting indicate satisfaction with the current program

SAFMC LAPPs/Catch Shares

Golden Crab Fishery

- 1) Currently working with fishermen to design a Catch Share Program
 - 2) 11 active permit holders, 6 active vessels
 - 3) Why a Catch Share Program for golden crab?
 - Resource will only support a limited fishery
 - With rising ex-vessel prices, a Catch Share Program could prevent a derby fishery and ensure overfishing does not occur
 - Reductions in other fisheries could result in more vessels entering the fishery
 - Fishing grounds are located adjacent to fragile coral HAPCs

Snapper Grouper Amendment 21
Comprehensive Snapper Grouper
Catch Share Program

- 1) LAPP Exploratory Workgroup established in 2007
- 2) Produced a report defining the conservation, economic and social benefits and drawbacks of a LAPP
- 3) Public scoping meetings were held in 2008 there was very little industry support and the Council decided not to proceed with development
- 4) Council is currently reexamining implementing a Catch Share Program for the snapper grouper fishery as industry support has recently increased

(Scoping scheduled for January/February 2011)
