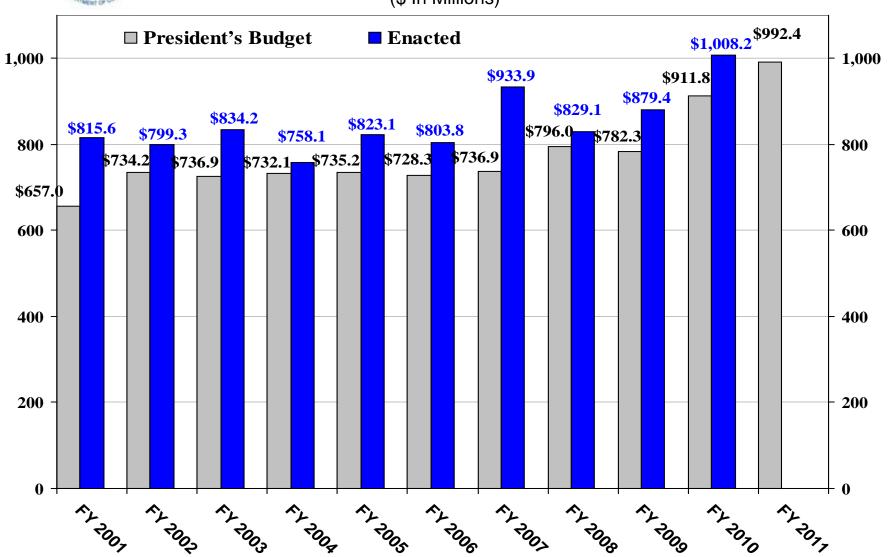

Historical NMFS Budget Trends

(\$ In Millions)







American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

- \$156M of the \$167M received for habitat restoration has been obligated to date (84%)
- Of the 50 ARRA projects selected:
 - Implementation efforts have begun on all projects
 - Construction has started on 39 projects
- Performance to date (counted after project construction is completed):
 - 306 acres of habitat restored (of the 8,770 acre target)
 - 74 stream miles made accessible (of the 715 stream mile target)
- As of end of 2nd quarter (March 2010)
 - 868 FTEs have been created/retained (cumulative for 3 quarters of reporting)

The FY 2010 Enacted Budget

TOTAL FUNDING = \$1,008.2 M

- \$904.5 M for Operations, Research, and Facilities (ORF)
- \$80.0 M for Pacific Coastal Salmon Recovery Fund
- \$0.0 M for Procurement, Acquisition and Construction (PAC)
- \$23.6 M in Other Funding

- \$5.0 M for Observers

Fisheries Management

- \$15.0 M for Fisheries Research and Management
- \$4.0 M for Regional Fishery Management Councils
- \$7.6 M for Enforcement
- \$1.0 M for Deep Sea Corals









Regional Fishery Management Councils' FY 2010 Budget

- In FY 2010, NMFS requested an increase of \$4.6 M:
 - \$0.6M to cover fixed costs associated with Council Operations
 - \$4.0M to set, evaluate, and revise ACLs and AMs to end overfishing and to develop amendments to FMPs that implement ACLs and AMs

Fisheries Management Council Grants

- Administrative Awards have been obligated for all 8 Councils
- Administrative Awards are 5 Year Multi-Year Awards
- Processing and Obligation encountered delays
 - Late Appropriations
 - Allotment Process after the Appropriation
 - Pre-review Process at NOAA Grants Management Division
 - Unrealistic Budgets could not be Reviewed or Approved by NOAA



Catch Shares

- Funding for Regional Councils for development of new catch shares:
 - FY 2010 included \$1.0 M
 - FY 2011 Includes a \$2.0 M increase (for a total of \$3.0 M)

FY 2011 NMFS Overview

- FY 2011 budget provides \$992.4 M, a \$15.8 M decrease from the FY 2010 Omnibus.
 - Funds Inflationary Adjustments to Base
 - Supports NOAA priorities to transform fisheries and protected resources management and support vibrant coastal communities and healthy ecosystems
 - Supports implementation of Catch Shares Programs to rebuild sustainable fisheries stocks and add significant jobs and profitability to U.S. fisheries
 - Seeks to close the gap in conservation of protected species including marine mammals and sea turtles
 - Advances ecosystem-based management and research on climate impacts
 - Seeks to protect and restore the Chesapeake Bay which is an environmental, economic, and recreational resource
 - Addresses the Administration's Priorities
 - Interagency Ocean Policy Task Force
 - Science and Technology
 - Other Task Forces: Climate and Energy, Ecosystem Restoration, Place-Based Policies
 - Addresses Congressional Priorities

Balanced Scorecard

- NOAA is moving to a Balance Scorecard approach to performance planning and reporting
- Cascades from high-level DOC themes and goals to NOAA objectives and performance measures
- Arrays performance measures by the objectives in the NexGen Strategic Plan
- Approach ensures a balance in performance tracking
 - Tracks high-level outcomes as well as lower level outputs
 - Includes programmatic as well as supporting infrastructure measures





High Priority Performance Goals (HPPG)

- Ensure that all 46 Federal fishery management plans have required catch limits to end overfishing in place by the end of 2011
- Reduce the number of stocks subject to overfishing to zero by the end of 2011
- Improve the Fish Stock Sustainability Index (FSSI) to 586 by the end of 2011
