




- Executive Summary
 - Regional differences exist in SSC operating procedures and practices in peer review
 - ✓ Reflects geographic and socioeconomic diversity
 - ✓ Fishery data availability
 - ACLs will be difficult in data limited regions
 - There is an increase in SSC responsibilities
 - SSCs should be final arbiter of BSIA

Establishing a Scientific Basis for ACLs




- National Standard 2: Best scientific information and role of SSC in the review of scientific information.
- National Standard 1: ACLS and scientific uncertainty
 - ✓ Overview from each regional SSC
 - Hitting the target (ACLs, max economic yield, management strategy evaluation, management uncertainty)
 - Other issues (catch shares, marine recreational information, marine protected areas, ecosystem)

• Executive Summary



- Different approaches exist for incorporating scientific uncertainty into ACLs
- A general understanding was reached about the SSC's role to provide advice to the Council on what represents BSIA
- The technical peer review should occur early enough into the process to inform the SSC when they make fishing level recommendations
- SAFE reports should be requirement in all regions.
- Development of a risk policy is a Council responsibility, informed by science
