Process for Sanctuaries	Motion: The CCC submit a letter to the Office of National Marine Sanctuaries and the National Marine Fisheries Service that acknowledges a shared responsibility to conserve and sustainably manage the nation's living marine resources. Accordingly, there should be a reasonable process that allows both the Council and Sanctuary to carry out their missions and achieve their objectives with minimum conflict.
