#### Regional Plans paint a national ET picture

- Viewed together, the Regional Plans show a national picture of ET being implemented in regionally oriented way.
- This national picture shows
  - Level of ET activity nationally
  - Need for support to implement Regional Plan elements
  - Allows comparison among regions to focus on future ET work

# EM with catch accounting coming in 3 regions

- Significant learning, experience
- Needs iterative process with communication, collaboration

#### What's not in Regional Plans?

- ET efforts being done but not in Regional Plans
  - FDD Integration
    - Common data identifier for all trip records
    - Starting in Greater Atlantic region
    - Future expansion to other regions
- R&D needs for EM implementation
- Other missing components?



#### Ongoing needs for ET effort

- Cost accounting on all ET projects
- Cost sharing information
  - Cost share provisions
  - Transition
- R & D
  - Automatic Image Recognition
  - Data Storage
  - Data Transfer

## **Next Steps**

- Review of Regional Plan progress by Regulatory and Science Boards
  - Twice annually
  - Criteria
    - Number of FMPs with defined FDD data collection monitoring goals
    - Number of FMPs reviewed to determine where additional ET would be appropriate for achieving data needs
    - As appropriate, the number of FMPs with ET incorporated in FDD data collection programs

## **Summary**

- Regional Plans show nationwide efforts on ET, tailored to regional needs and capabilities
- Learning in next few years will be significant as new EM programs are implemented
- Ongoing process to
  - Evaluate progress by region
  - Incorporate new ET programs
  - Continue needed R&D
