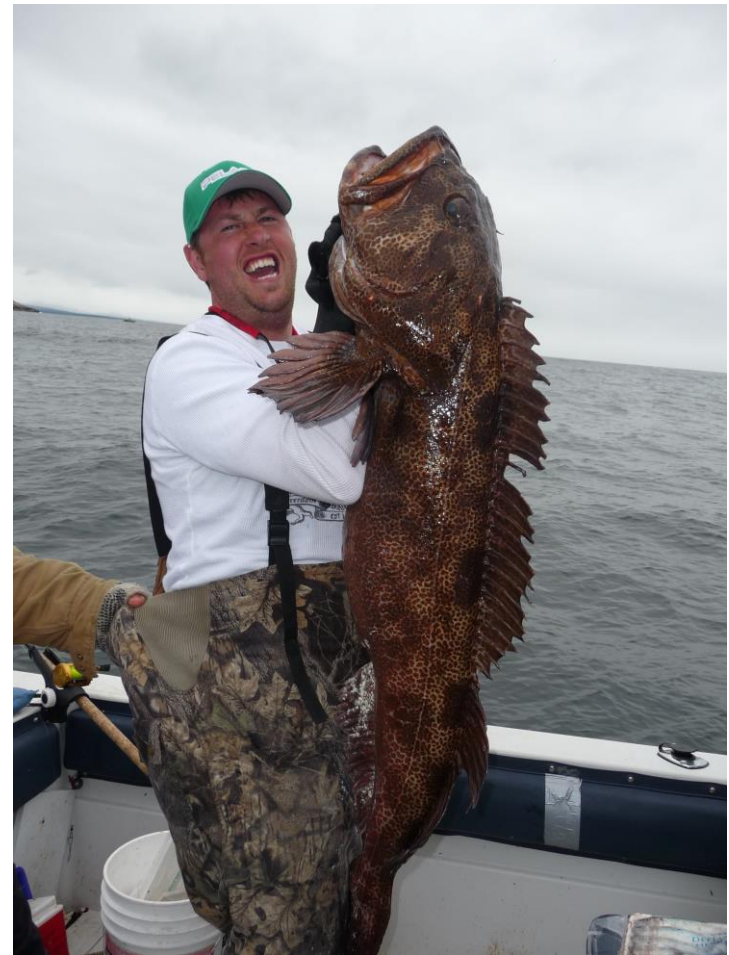

Stocks Subject to Overfishing In the Pacific Council:

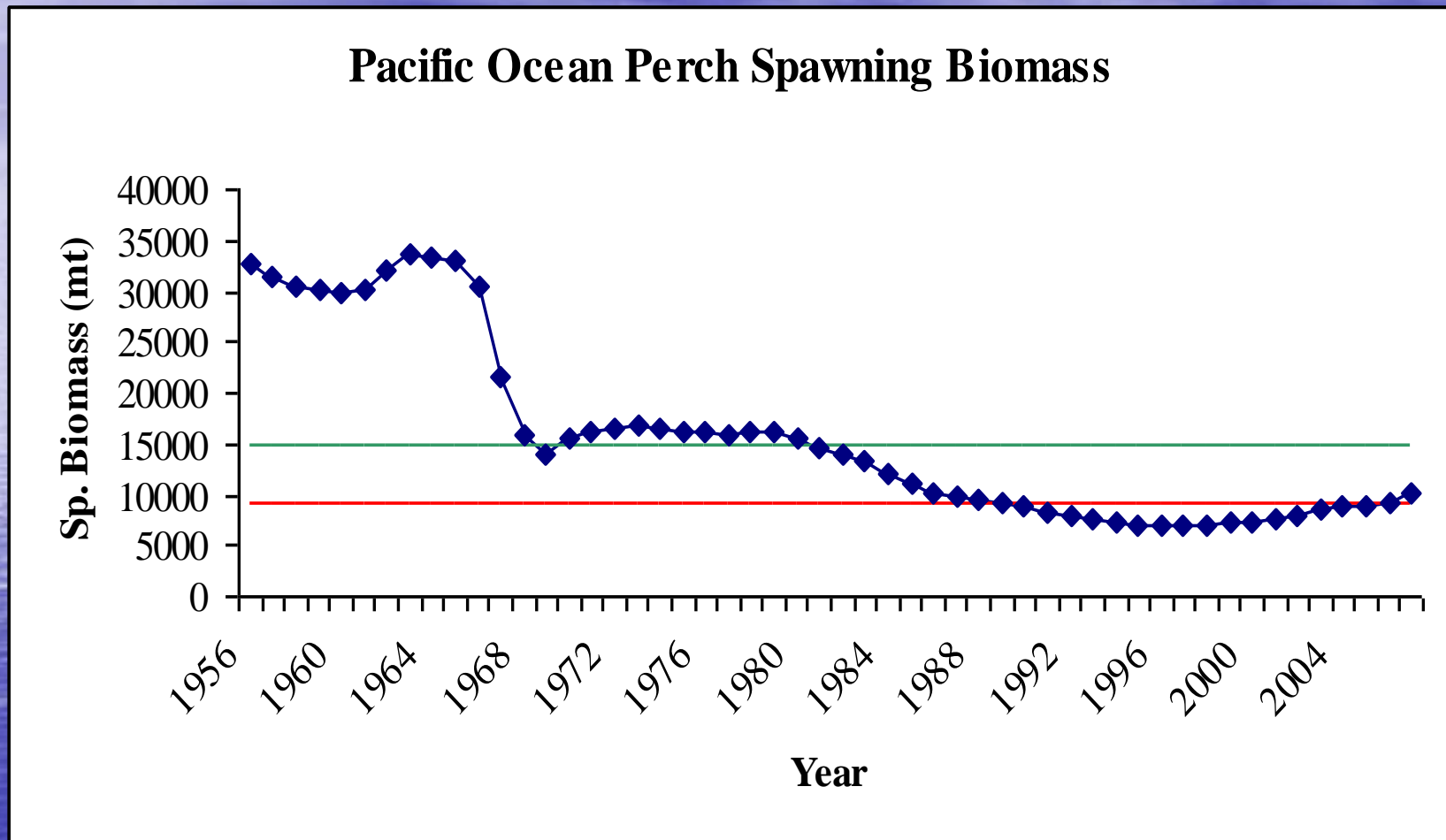

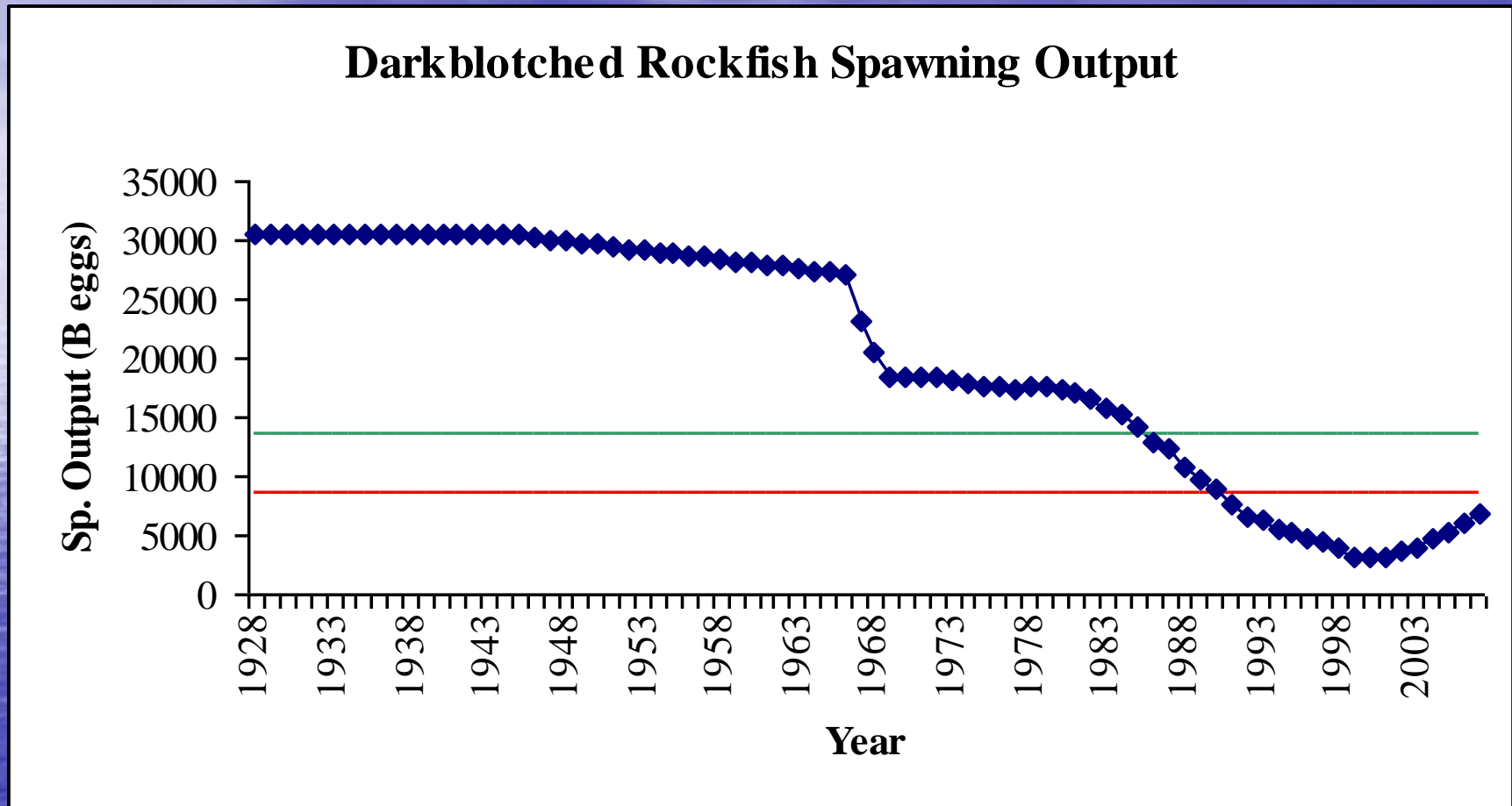


Pacific Ocean Perch: Improving



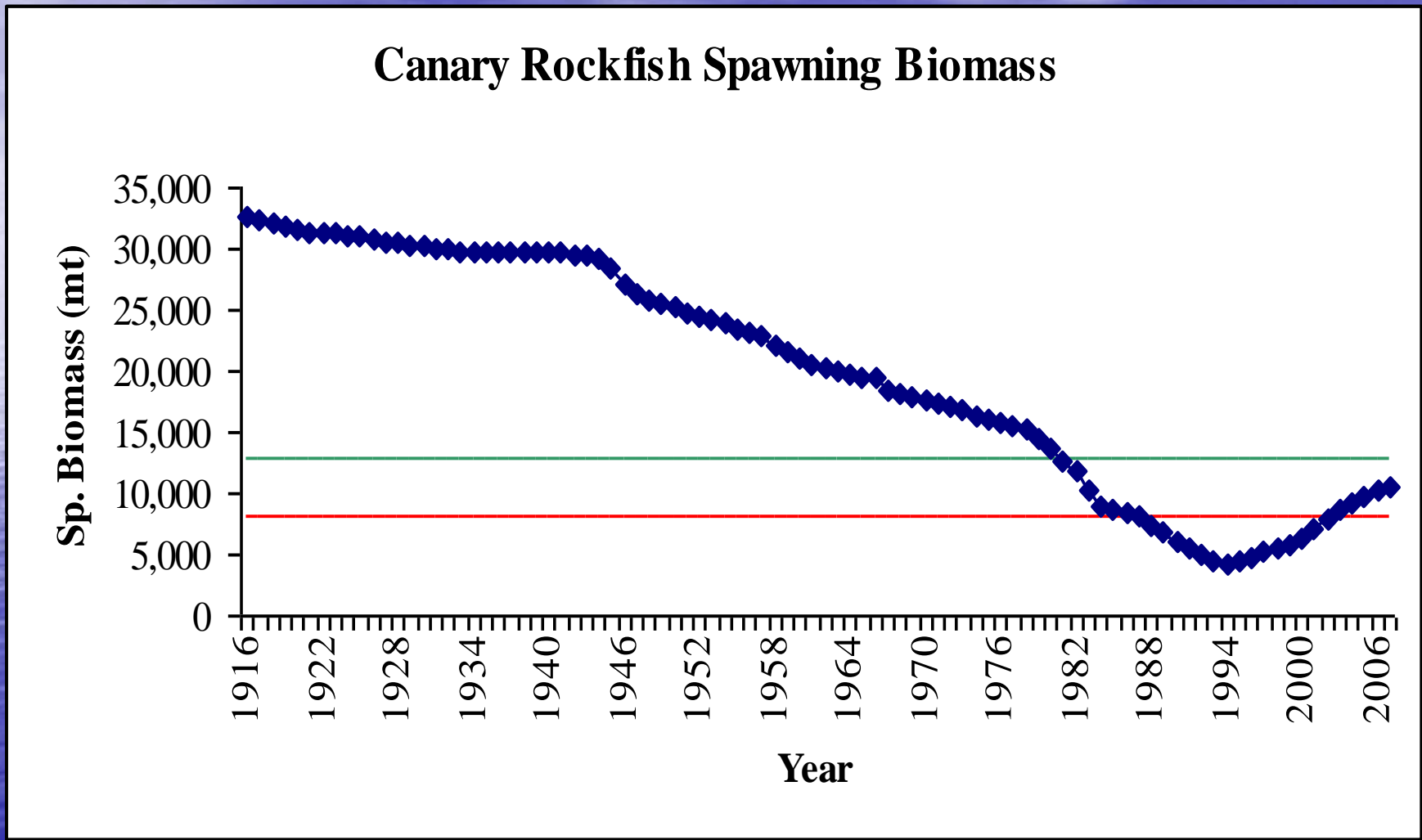
Year to Rebuilt: 2017

Darkblotched Rockfish: Improving



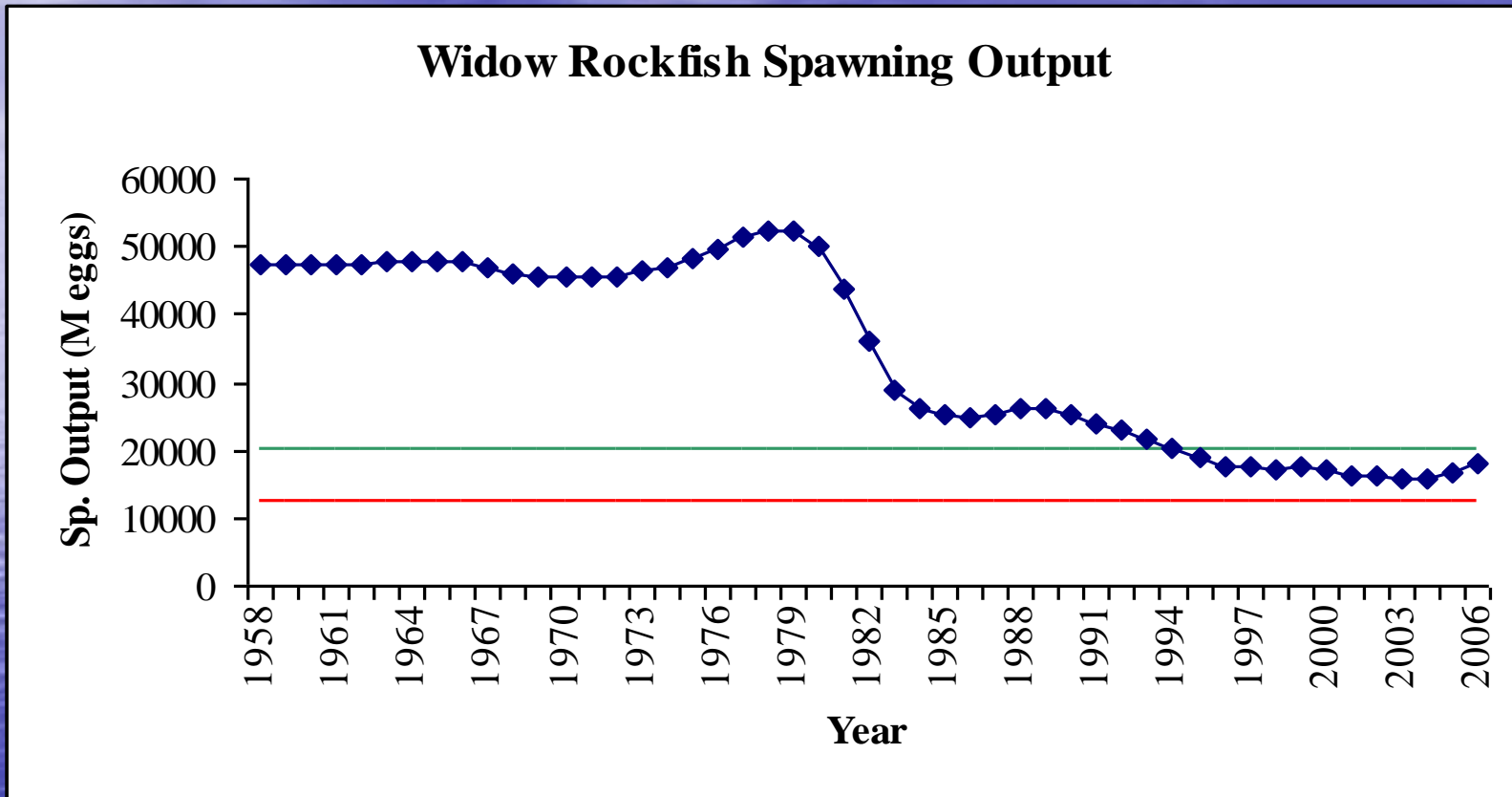

Canary Rockfish: Improving



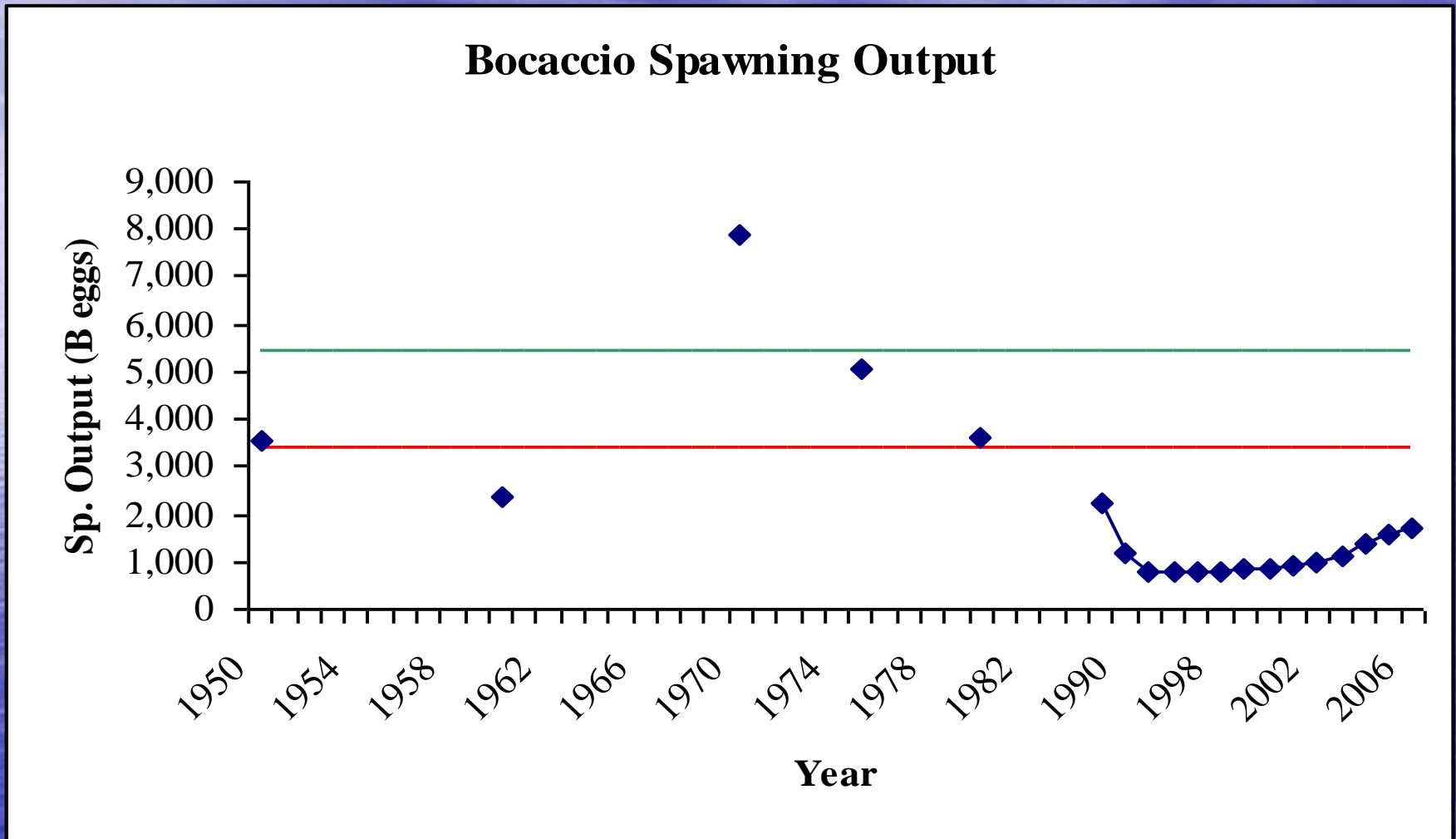

Widow Rockfish: Improving



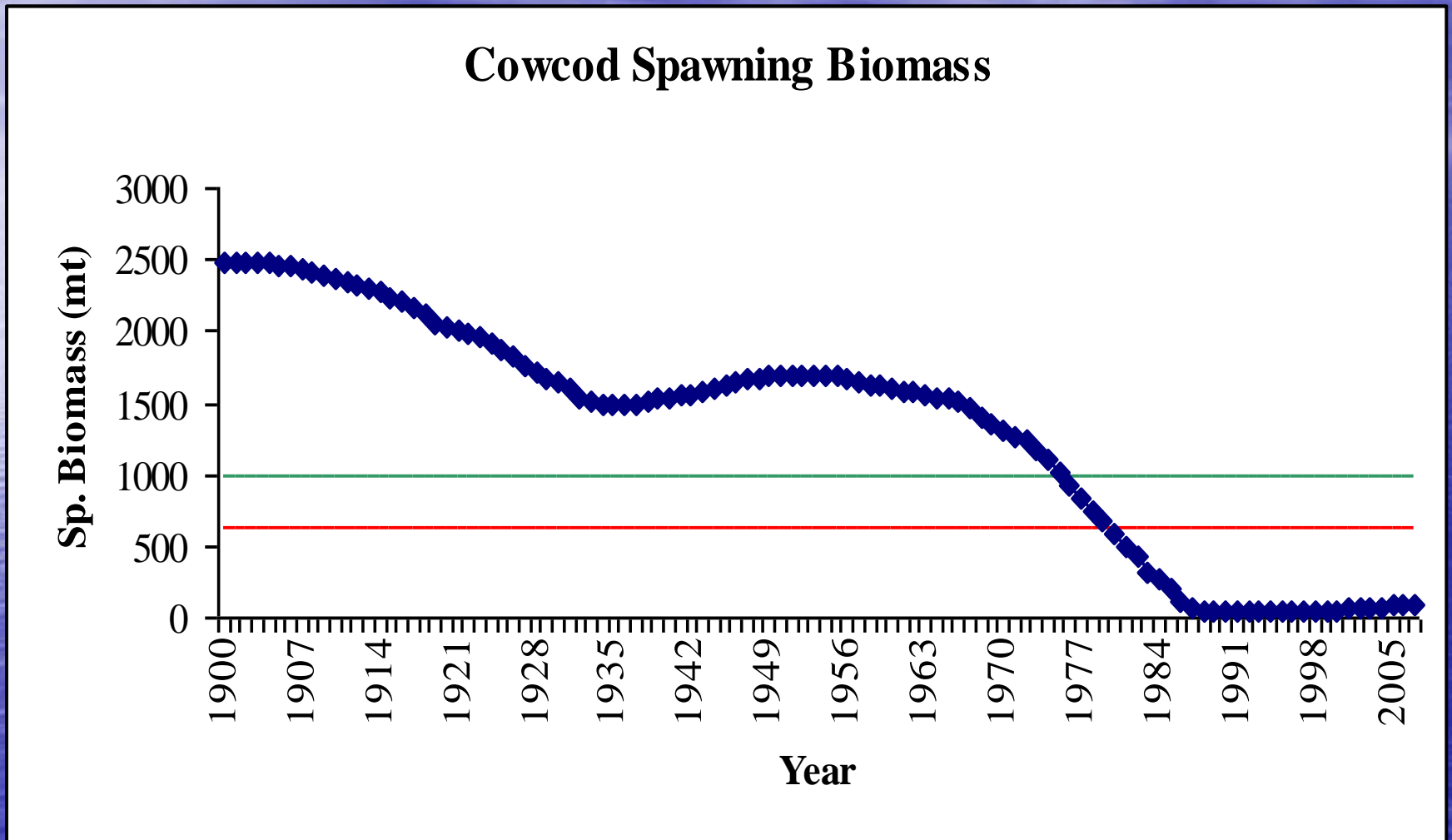

Bocaccio Rockfish: Improving



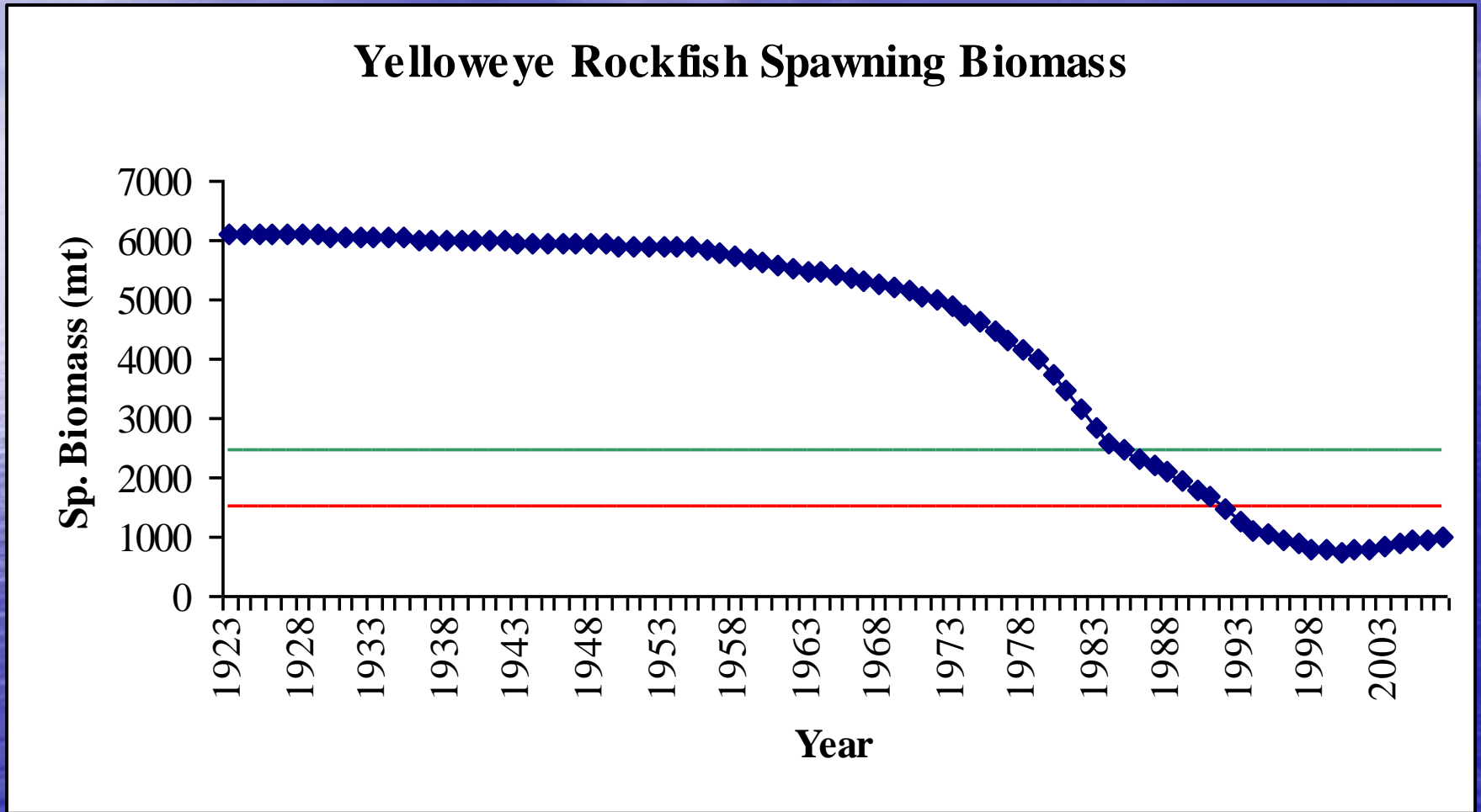

ACLs and AMs

- January 2009: Rule Out
- February 2009: CCC Funding Decisions--How much \$\$ and who does what?
- Initial Scoping:
 - Are FMP Amendments necessary for each FMP?
 - What is a reasonable schedule?
 - What are the key issues?



Reasonable Schedule



- Initial scoping
- First draft, with alternatives and some analysis
- Adopt draft for public review
- Council final action
- Secretarial approval process



Salmon

- Overfished and overfishing definitions
- Review of Sacramento R fall chinook MSY ?
- Possible Schedule:

Scoping: **April, 2009**

First Analysis: **Sept, 2009**

Public Review Draft: **April, 2010**

Final Council Action: **September, 2010**

Secretarial Approval: **Jan 1, 2011 (May 1 reg. changes)**



Groundfish

- Accelerated schedule to mesh with Biennial Specs process



- Possible Schedule:

Scoping: **April, 2009**

First Analysis: **June, 2009**

Public Review Draft: **September, 2009**

Final Council Action: **November, 2009**

Secretarial Approval: **June, 2010 (Fishing regs Jan 1, 2011)**





HMS and CPS FMPs:

- Four Council Meeting processes
- Final Council action by 2010 that mesh with Secretarial approval process prior to fishing regulations that begin in 2011
